

Chairlift Mechanic - Full-Time - Seasonal

Job Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the complete maintenance of a group of lifts, performing all routine and assigned maintenance procedures under the guidance of Lift Maintenance leadership
- Assist in ongoing training and support of lift operators.
- Be able to follow safety and risk management policies and procedures
- Responsible for immediately communicating all abnormal or unusual conditions, incidents, observations or system malfunctions to Lift Maintenance leadership
- Maintains tools, equipment, and workspace in clean and orderly manner
- Diagnoses issues and reports potential issues to lift maintenance leadership
- Operate all vehicles, including snowmobiles, in a safe and efficient manner
- Other duties as assigned

Job Requirements:

- Excellent knowledge of hydraulics, rigging, and troubleshooting skills
- Must have or ability to obtain a valid US driver's license
- Ability to work efficiently at heights
- Able to lift & carry up to 50 lbs.
- Able to work outdoors in adverse mountain winter weather conditions
- Must be willing to work flexible schedule, including weekends, holidays, evening shifts, etc.
- On-site training provided by ski area for lift mechanics both before and throughout employment

Individual compensation decisions are based on a variety of factors and will be discussed during the interview process. This is a seasonal, full time position. However, this position has the possibility of growing into a full-time year round position that includes health insurance, dental insurance, and other benefits.
