

Welch Village Learning Center Snowboard and Freestyle Supervisor

Purpose

The Snowboard Supervisor is a key member of the Learning Center Team who leads the selection, training and scheduling of snowboard instructor staff. As a member of the Learning Center Team, the Snowboard Supervisor will help to plan lesson content, lesson structure, sales limits and coordination of new lesson offerings. In addition to the responsibilities presented, the Snowboard Supervisor will plan an active role in the ongoing leadership of the Freestyle program at Welch Village. This important role has a high degree of visibility within the Learning Center Staff structure as well as with customers.

Responsibilities

- Recruit, select and train snowboard instruction staff that fit the Welch Village Learning Center culture.
- Develop lesson curriculum which meets customer needs for beginner to intermediate snowboard learning environment.
- Teach snowboard lessons on a daily basis.
- Help to greet guests as they arrive for lessons and organize them into groups.
- Align staff in accordance with Learning Center culture and criteria.
- Recruit and act in a leadership role for Freestyle Team.
- Provide a supportive and inclusive environment within the snow sports Learning Center.

Qualifications

- Five or more years as a snowboard instructor
- AASI Level 2 or above current and in good standing with both National and Central
- Demonstrated experience working with and performing in a leadership role of a Freestyle Team
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to resolve issues with collaboration and focus on effective resolution
- Demonstrated ability to handle challenging staff and/or customer situations
- High degree of mentoring capability with a focus on development
- Focus on safety and learning

Physical Requirements

- Ability to ride snowboard in a variety of conditions
- Lift up to 75 lbs on an occasional basis
- Must be willing and able to assist students with riding magic carpet and chairlift
- Ability to bend, squat and grasp

- Handle exposure to varying temperatures and conditions
- Must be able to walk on uneven surfaces
